As most Rolex models have holes in the case where the push pin is holding the bracelet tight to the case, by using a small pin, it 's easy to remove the bracelet and write down the serial and reference number of your Rolex. At the end of this report I will summarize the most used Rolex reference numbers for you.

In the same way that Rolex serial numbers allow you to date the year of your Rolex you can also date the year of your Rolex bracelet. Rolex bracelet codes are found on the inner part of the Rolex bracelet clasp and started in the 1950 ' s when Rolex also began stamping the inner caseback of their watches.

The Rolex serial numbers are found between the lugs on the side of the case at the 6 o ' clock side, behind the bracelet. This 4-8 digit number is engraved by Rolex on every watch and it can be used to determine its production date.

One of Rolex ' s famous bracelets, the President bracelet includes a semi-circular three-link configuration. It is exclusively manufactured in either 18k gold or platinum and is always fitted with a Crownclasp. This

bracelet made its debut on the Day-Date watch in 1956 and today, the Day-Date is often referred to as the Rolex President.
