The book is written in a style accessible to the layperson, while including sufficient technical details to satisfy more knowledgeable

readers. It also captures the excitement and wonder of spaceflight, making extensive use of astronaut biographies and interviews to uncover the real human experience, as much as technical information to provide detail to satisfy those curious about 'how it works'.
