Excerpt from Questions and Answers Covering the History of Russia and the Causes of the World War The Russian empire comprises one-seventh of the land surface of the globe, its area being, since the Treaty of Portsmouth (September 5, 1905), and making no allowance for territory captured and occupied by the forces of the central powers in the existing war, 8,417,118 English square miles, of which 2,122,999 square miles are located in Europe (including Russian Poland and Ciscaucasian provinces and Finland); and 6,294,119 square miles in Asia, nearly five million square miles of the Asiatic territory being comprised in Siberia. These totals do not include the area covered by the internal waters of the empire, the seas of Azov, Caspian, Lake Aral, etc., occupying an additional 347,468 square miles. The total population of this territory, estimated on the basis of the census of 1897 and the yearly increase thereby shown, was about 178,000,000 inhabitants. The government of Russia, which from the beginning of its history has been an absolute despotism, since 1905 has become a constitutional hereditary monarchy,

although as a matter of fact the legislative, executive and judicial power still remain vested to a very large extent in the emperor or tsar, who still retains his ancient title "Autocrat of all the Russias." The first step toward establishing a representative form of government was taken on August 6 (19) 1905; an elective body called the State Duma was created but with only consultative power.
