natural history, especially in the ten volumes of *Souvenirs Entomologiques*. Although a reclusive amateur, with no scientific training, he was an acute observer of insect behavior. He combined his observations (most made in his own backyard) with a humanistic writing style that made his books

popular, at least later in his life; during most of his life, the successive volumes of *Souvenirs Entomologiques* attracted only mild attention. Fabre was 84 when the last volume appeared, and soon afterward he was "discovered." He was elected to numerous scientific societies, provided a government

pension, and even the President of France came to visit him.
