Veblen's distinction between "institutions" and "technology" is still called the Veblenian dichotomy by contemporary economists. In the beginning of his academic career Veblen had difficulties obtaining a university position, whether because he was discriminated for being Norwegian, or openly identified

as an agnostic. These difficulties later inspired him to write *The Higher Learning in America*. In this book he claimed that true academic values were sacrificed by universities in favor of their own self-interest and profitability. _x000D_
