All philosophical systems start with axioms. Summary. The doctrine of the authority and inerrancy of Scripture is rooted in the doctrine of God; as God is true and trustworthy, so is his word recorded in the original autographs of Scriptures. This means that all things that the Scriptures assert are wholly true, both in the Old Testament, the Scriptures of Jesus and the apostles, and in the New Testament, the writings of the apostles.

## The Authority of Scripture According to Scripture\*

The Authority of Scripture necessary to maintain that the pointing of the Massoretic text of the Old Testament belonged to the original autographs;2 and that the Greek of the New Testament must be pure, free of the vulgarisms of the spoken Greek of the time and of Hebraisms in construction, otherwise God's credit as an author would be compromised.3 Thank fully I know of no evangelical today who would wish to pitch his first line of defence at such an indefensible position.

The phrase the "authority of Scripture" most basically and most easily means nothing more than God is the author of Scripture, therefore Scripture is authoritative for life.

The reliability and authority of the Bible may be handled by considering Scripture ' s (1) inspiration, (2) inerrancy and infallibility, and (3) clarity and sufficiency. As we consider these marks of God ' s Word, we are reminded that the Bible is both utterly reliable and completely authoritative; believers can depend on it, and believers must yield to it.

For Barth, the Bible ' s authority is purely derived from its function, and that function is to point to God himself, that " Other Thing " by which Barth meant revelation (for Barth, God in personal encounter with us through Jesus Christ is revelation), who is the real authority. In and of itself,

Scripture has no authority, and it is easy to see why Barth held that view.
