Since the Constitution was ratified in 1789, more than eleven thousand amendments have died or been shunted aside. With 27 of today's state legislatures controlled by Republicans, 17 by Democrats and six split, it is difficult to see success for any of Justice Stevens' proposals, even the ones that are not strictly partisan.
