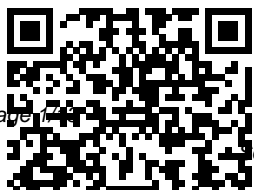

It is commonly believed that macroeconomic models are not useful for policy analysis because they do not take proper account of agents' expectations.
