Too small of a gap may give too weak of a spark to complete the combustion process within the engine; too wide of a gap can lead to the spark plug not firing correctly, causing misfires

at high speeds.

Electrode Gap. The electrode gap of a spark plug dictates the spark magnitude. An incorrect electrode gap may affect engine performance as the spark magnitude may be insufficient to ensure complete combustion of the air-fuel mixture.

By adjusting this distance you are said to be 'gapping your spark plugs'. With the aid of a feeler gauge and the following advice, this adjustment is certainly something that you can do yourself.. A spark plug gap is the distance between the end of the electrode and the base of the spark plug. If your spark plugs aren't properly gapped, your engine may not burn fuel properly. Since every make and model requires a different gap size, start by looking in the owner's manual for your vehicle to find the required gap size,

or pull the information up online.

The gap between the center and side electrodes of a spark plug must be an exact distance; otherwise, your plugs don't fire efficiently. Adjusting the distance between the two electrodes is called gapping your spark plugs. You need a feeler gauge to gap your spark plugs properly. Gap new as well as old spark plugs, [...]

Spark plug gap refers to the gap between the spark plug center electrode and the grounding electrode. The gap spacing of general spark plugs is between 0.6 and 1.3 mm. The larger the spark plug gap is, the longer the arc will be generated when igniting.
