diffusion of a solvent (water) through a selectively permeable membrane. -water diffuses through membrane pores (aquaporins) or directly through the lipid part of the membrane from a solution of lesser osmolarity to a solution of greater osmolarity. ---particles move from crowded area to not crowded area.
