Psalm 1. Psalms comprise the Prayer Book of the Bible. The meaning of Psalms is “ songs of praise, ” from the original Hebrew title Tehillim. The five divisions or books within the Book correspond to the five books of Torah (Genesis, Exodus, Numbers, Leviticus, Deuteronomy) given by Moses. The first 41 songs are in Book One.
