Sugarcane needs to be placed next to water. It also does not grow any faster on sand or on dirt. So, I would recommend dirt because it ' s cheaper and because you don ' t need to place a block under it. Sand is more expensive and requires you to place a block under it for the sand to stay up.

Introduction to Growing Sugarcane - Smart Fertilizer

Sugarcane can grow in various types of soils – sandy, loamy, and clay soils, as well as both acidic and alkaline soils (within the pH range of 5 to 8.5). A well-drained loam with a pH of roughly 6.5 is absolutely ideal, but mechanical factors, such as soil compaction, are much more consequential to crop success than soil composition and pH.

Sugarcane does not wither. You can plant it anywhere and leave it to be harvested later. The cane grows back by itself - you don't have to plant it again (except after a periodical ploughing). Cane, like grains, requires ploughing (or use of a subsoiler) every 3rd harvest.

Sugar cane can generate naturally up to four blocks tall, but short plants grow only to a height of three blocks, adding a block of height when the top sugar cane block has received 16 random block ticks (i.e. on average every 18 minutes on Java Edition or 54 minutes on Bedrock Edition, but the actual rate can vary widely). Sugar cane must be planted on a grass block, dirt, coarse dirt, podzol ...

Container Growing. Sugarcane plants grow very well in patio

containers. Allow enough room for growth generally a 18 to a 24 diameter, 10 deep container will suffice. Remember the looser the roots, the taller and healthier your plant will be. When the plant becomes root bound its growth will slow. At that point it is time for a larger pot.
