Once loaded, the weapon cycles and functions the same as service ammunition and marks the target with minimal hazard to personnel wearing appropriate safety equipment. The system allows

normal weapon employment cues such as aiming, firing, Force-On-Force training, and interactive live-fire scenario task and mission execution.
