Tenebrism Versus Chiaroscuro. Caravaggism embraces both chiaroscuro and tenebrism. Because both techniques involve the pronounced use of light and shadow, they can be confused, even though there is a clear theoretical difference between the two terms.

*Tenebrism Light And Shadow 1*

Chiaroscuro, technique employed in the visual arts to represent light and shadow as they define three-dimensional objects. In European painting the technique was first brought to its full potential by Leonardo da Vinci in the late 15th century in such paintings as his Adoration of the Magi (1481).

There's very little warmth in the shadows. Caravaggio is almost synonymous with Tenebrism. His depiction of shadow and light is almost violent. In the negative space one

can almost see forerunners of Abstraction. The dark is almost a strict absence of light forming negative space as in this depiction of Narcissus.
