The Americans Chapter 26 Terms. 1956 Egyptian president Nasser seizes control of Suez Canal after France and Britain withdraw financial support for new Egyptian dam over Nasser's friendliness to USSR. France, Britain, and Israel invade Egypt; USSR threatens to bomb France and Britain; US threatens to intervene. Crisis ends with United Nations negotiated cease fire.
