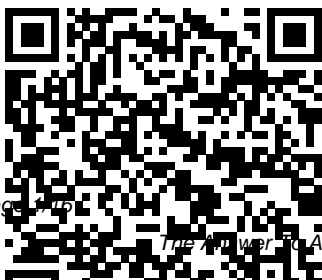

The challenge that de Botton addresses in his book: how to separate ideas and practices from the religious institutions that have laid claim to them. In *Religion for Atheists* is an argument to free our soul-related needs from the particular influence of religions,

even if it is, paradoxically, the study of religion that will allow us to rediscover and rearticulate those needs.
