If your license expires, you may apply for renewal of the license for another term during a two-year filing grace period. The application document must be received by the FCC on or before the end of the grace period. Unless and until the license is renewed, no amateur operator or station operating privileges are conferred.

Which Exam to Take? - ham radio license exam

New club station license applicants can register their club information with the FCC and receive a FRN before the club application is submitted to ARRL. This FRN number should be included on the club application form so it can be associated to the new club station license and station call sign.

If you held a Technician class ham radio license issued before March 21, 1987, the FCC gives you

“grandfather” credit for the General class exam (element 3). If your Technician license has not expired (because you have been renewing it every 10 years), you can get an automatic upgrade to the General class without passing any exams.

US licenses are good for 10 years before renewal and anyone may hold one except a representative of a foreign government. In the US there are three license classes—Technician, General and Extra.

ARRL's third edition of the Ham Radio License Manual is designed for the aspiring ham radio operator. The material

Through the ARRL - If you are an ARRL member, you can use the NCVEC 605 form and mail your renewal to the ARRL. Through the FCC - You can mail the official FCC forms directly to the FCC. At a VE Test Session - You can upgrade your license at any ARRL VE test session and at the same time renew your license (even if you don't actually earn an upgrade) for no additional cost.

How to Get an Amateur Radio License in the US: 5 Steps

Note: In 2007 the FCC eliminated the Morse code examination requirement for all classes of amateur radio licenses. Of course, while there are no more Morse code exams, lots of ham radio operators still use Morse code, and you're free to join in.
