Perhaps it 's a function of having had a prestigious education at the Iowa Writers ' Workshop that the scatter of words like "striate", "strafe", "rime" and "rinse" appear in so much literary academic fiction, nevertheless, Nam Le seems to find new ways to manipulate a supple language to give us his "scree of bodies" and "inlet of neck" in *The Boat*, a face "crimped in fear" and a truck ripping "skins of water off the bitumen" in *Halfhead Bay*.
