If you tend to hit the ball toward the toe or high in the face, this driver turns the directional miss and distance loss minimal. The mid-handicap players I play with who have this driver often tell me they toe'd a drive, we look at the face and yes it's high on the toe, yet the ball has gone the same distance as the middle hits.

The main technique remains the same, but with the driver your body is positioned slightly different than when hitting an iron or wedge. During the swing, your arms remain still (same as iron) as you come through to hit the ball. The most common mishits come from an individual swinging the driver like they are trying to hit the ball 3 miles.
