Differentiated instruction and co-teaching in a general education classroom make it easier for students with standards-based IEPs to be taught the same material as their classmates. In some schools, only certain classrooms are designated as inclusive.

Pros and Cons of Differentiated Teaching in School

Inclusive education and differentiated instruction are two methods of teaching that attempt to reach all students,

regardless of disability or skill level. However, the two are not mutually exclusive; if anything, inclusive classrooms are the result of teachers mastering the art of differentiated instruction.

Tomlinson describes differentiated instruction as factoring students' individual learning styles and levels of readiness first before designing a lesson plan. Research on the effectiveness of differentiation shows this method benefits a wide range of students, from those with learning disabilities to those who are considered high ability.
