Posthumously, two updated volumes of her poetry were released, *The Last Lunar Baedeker* (1985) and *The Lost Lunar Baedeker* (1997), both edited by Roger L. Conover. *Songs to Joannes* is in *The Lost Lunar Baedeker*.

Her only novel, *Insel*, was published posthumously in 1991. It is about the relationship between a German artist, *Insel*, and an art dealer, Mrs. Jones.

Only selected poems from *Lunar Baedeker* appeared in the 1958 publication of *Lunar Baedeker and Time-Tables*, and since then, *The Last Lunar Baedeker* (1982) collects and reorganizes Loy's entire body of poetry. *The Lost Lunar Baedeker* (1996) does not contain all the original Baedeker poems, nor does it adhere to the original order.
