Dougherty writes of his seemingly hopeless job prospects as an untrained civilian during Germany ' s hyperinflation and unemployment, and his joining the Nazi party through the attraction to Nazism of his fiancé e, Lina von Osten, and her father, along with the rumor shadowing him of a strain of Jewishness inherited from his father ' s side. And we follow Heydrich ' s meteoric rise through the Nazi high command—from SS major, to colonel to brigadier general, before he was thirty, deputy to Heinrich Himmler, expanding the SS, the Gestapo, and developing the Reich's plans for "the Jewish solution." And throughout, we hear the voice of Lina Heydrich, who was by his side until his death at the age of thirty-eight, living inside the Nazi inner circles as she waltzed with Rudolf Hess, feuded with Hermann G ö ring, and drank vintage wine with Albert Speer.
