Chemistry Lab The Periodic Law Answer Key

Mendeleev, who first published his periodic table in 1869 (Figure 7.1.3), is usually credited with the origin of the modern periodic table. The key difference between his arrangement of the elements and that of Meyer and others is that Mendeleev did not assume that all the elements had been discovered (actually, only about two-thirds of the naturally occurring elements were known at the time).
