Chronology is, in this case, an elusive term. His life meanders between so many facets of artistic impulses, with images cross-pollinating over years and even decades, that the chronological line of his life is as dippy and curved as the architectural elements of a house in Who-ville. Therefore, this book is " chronological-ish. " That is to say, some things come at the right time and some at the wrong time. But just as Dr. Seuss taught us to look at life " through the wrong end of a telescope, " the iconic artwork packed into these pages helps us understand that it isn ' t always a straight line from here to there that matters . . . but rather the fun of the journey that really counts.
