Carole Pateman's theory of the sexual contract begins as a critique of this view. Pateman argues that Locke's view of the social contract completely ignored the position of women with respect to the state. This is the starting point of many feminist critiques of classical theories. Pateman argues that only men have a direct relationship with the state under classical Liberal democratic regimes and that women interact

with the state indirectly through the dominant male in their household.
