There are passageways between our world and Mid-World, and a New York City boy named Jake gets shoved in front of a car by Jack Mort ('death'), is killed, and finds himself alive in Roland's world. He becomes Roland's surrogate son. In book 2, 'The Drawing of the Three', Roland is attacked by marvelous, poisonous 'lobstrosities' and enters our world for help. He takes heroin addict Eddie Dean from 1987 New York and Odetta Holmes from 1964 New York as his

team. In a powerful time-tripping scene, Roland confronts Jack Mort and actually changes Jake's Earth history, which has heady implications for Roland's world.
