The earliest evidences for life on Earth are 3.8 billion-year-old biogenic hematite in a banded iron formation of the Nuvvuagittuq Greenstone Belt in Canada, graphite in 3.7 billion-year-old metasedimentary rocks discovered in western Greenland and microbial mat fossils found in 3.48 billion-year-old sandstone discovered in Western Australia.

Earth formed around 4.54 billion years ago, approximately one-third the age of the universe, by accretion from the solar nebula.

Volcanic outgassing probably created the primordial atmosphere and then the ocean, but the early atmosphere contained almost no

oxygen. Much of the Earth was molten because of frequent collisions with other bodies which led to extreme volcanism.
