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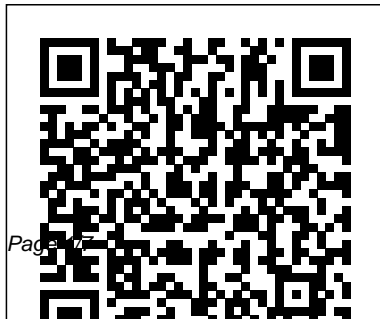

There are three different ways to approach third-person point of view in writing: Third-person omniscient point of view: The omniscient narrator knows everything about the story and its characters. This narrator can enter any character's mind, move freely through time, and give the reader their own opinions and

observations as well as those of the characters.

Examples of Third Person Writing. Third-person Objective. The narrator is a spectator of events. A novel written from an objective point of view does not contain references to thoughts or feelings, only reporting what can be seen and heard (like a roving movie camera).
