The Mystery of the Three Skeleton Keys Z.J. Cannon
The plays of Mar í a Mart í nez Sierra were popular in Spain, South America and in translation on Broadway and London's West End in the first half of the 20th century but they were thought to be written by her husband, the celebrated director and playwright Gregorio Mart í nez Sierra. After his death, the authorship of his work was revealed to be that of Mar í a, making her one of the most important
