The review focuses on four areas: (1) specifying what integration is (and is not); (2) detailing the process through which integrated care may affect clinical outcomes; (3) expanding beyond the scope of prior reviews to include multiple illnesses and patient populations; and (4) specifying the conditions under which various models of integrated care are likely (or unlikely) to work in 'real-world' settings.
