Hayden White nació en 1928 en Martin, Tennessee, una ciudad pequeña, emplazada en ese sur profundo de Estados Unidos, que vivía del cultivo de cereales y algodón. Luego de pasar por la experiencia de la segunda Guerra Mundial, se va a incorporar a la Wayne State University, a completar estudios de historia, asentándose como medievalista e historiador cultural. Su trayectoria como historiador de campo se vio interrumpida a principios de 1970 cuando publicó una serie de ensayos disruptivos que cuestionaban el estatuto epistemológico de la historia, que serán coronados con *Metahistoria* (1973).
