Handicap Index® multiplied
by Slope Rating® of tees
played, divided by Standard
Slope Rating (113) = Answer
(rounded to nearest whole
number, .4 rounds down and .5
rounds up) Example: 10.4
Handicap Index x 125 Slope

Rating / 113 Standard Slope
Rating = 11.5 = 12 Course
Handicap
