The ultimate authority in such matters is Webster's Third

New International Dictionary. In those relatively few instances where official Marine historical writing practices differ from these sources, this Writing Guide provides examples of the approved and generally long-established methodologies. This edition is a major revision of the last Writing Guide, which was published in October 1983. While most of the material in the previous edition is included in this iteration, it has been completely reorganized and numerous

additions have been made. It is the intent of the Marine Corps that its official historical works be accurate, objective, academically reputable and readable by a general audience interested in the subject matter.
