The Vietnam experience of youthful American combat soldiers was one of constant danger as well as confrontation with situations that many were unprepared to deal with. Well-armed and often immature, the soldiers sometimes made decisions which led to tragedy. Finally, there were

the farmers of Vietnam, who wanted nothing more than to remain in their fields near the tombs of their ancestors.
