The way of cloning projects with Visual Studio 2019 in Solution Explorer is very easy and simple.

Visual Studio: Copying files to Debug or Release folder ...

1. Close all Visual Studio Projects.
 2. Make a copy of the original project and store elsewhere (in case of problems).
 3. Use the copied folder as the new source folder. Below this source folder will be the 'tree' of associated folders (i.e. your project sub-folders)

- Visual Studio uses project GUIDs to identify different project files and their dependencies in a solution file, as well as for references between projects inside a single solution file. For this to work, it needs all project GUIDs to be unique inside a solution file.

Specifies the list of files to copy the source files to. This list is expected to be a one-to-one mapping with the list specified in the SourceFiles parameter. That is, the first file specified in SourceFiles will be copied to the first location specified in DestinationFiles, and so forth. DestinationFolder: Optional ITaskItem parameter.

"Copy to Output Directory" is the property of the files within a Visual Studio project, which defines if the file will be copied to the project's built path as it is. Coping the file as it is allows us to use relative path to files within the project.
