

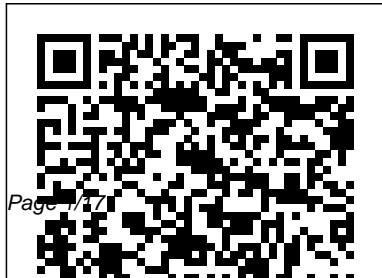

The purpose of this paper is to estimate the effectiveness of technical trading strategies and examine the extent to which trading profitability using technical analysis indicators explains the 'risk premium' or 'risk compensation' for investing

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in equity markets as against assets that are relatively risk-free using multiple regression analysis. The technical indicators selected for the analysis are Bollinger bands (volatility indicator), moving average (trend indicator), Relative Strength Index (momentum indicator), and Elliot wave theory (mass psychology indicator). A positive relationship implies that technical indicators can be explored while evaluating strategies for investment.
