#### Vampire Witch Trilogy

In 1896, French magician and filmmaker George Méliès brought forth the first celluloid vampire in his film *Le manoir du diable*. The vampire continues to be one of film's most popular gothic monsters and in fact, today more people become acquainted with the vampire through film than through literature, such as Bram Stoker's classic *Dracula*. How has this long legacy of

celluloid vampires affected our understanding of vampire mythology? And how has the vampire morphed from its folkloric and literary origins?
