Photo 3: Repair the wall. Apply a selfsticking metal screen patch (about \$4 at home centers) over the hole after removing the patch and old paper. Apply two coats of joint compound in thin layers, feathering it out at the edges and sanding the repair flat. Since the hole repair will be covered by wallpaper, it doesn't have to look as perfect as a regular wall repair.

Considerations for Drywall Repair Kits If your hole is larger than 4 inches in width and height, it's best to repair the wall rather than use a patch kit. Be sure to pick up drywall repair panels and drywall repair clips. If there's a small hole in your wall and you're a novice in drywall work, think about choosing a repair kit.

Use this 3 oz. Stick-Ease Wall Covering Seam Adhesive for loose sealing seams, edges, corners of wallpaper and borders. This repair adhesive can fix tears in wall coverings, and it bonds vinyl where overlapping is necessary. It may require several hours for thorough drying and can be easily applied using the applicator tube.

Small-Area Repairs Cut the loose edges from the drywall paper with a utility knife. Sand the edges where paper was removed with a fine-grit sanding pad. Wipe the sanding dust with a clean cloth.

Gently rub a wet sponge over the repair, turning it each time to avoid getting adhesive on the wallpaper. This helps seal the seam and removes any excess adhesive from the wall. Larger or More...

In the case of vinyl wallpaper, you will have to cut into the bubble with a small utility knife, in an "X" pattern. Peel back the edges slightly and apply new adhesive underneath with a small paintbrush. Then, smooth over it again with a damp sponge and wipe away any excess adhesive. Debris beneath the wallpaper will need to be cut out.

Decide whether you want to repaint the whole wall or just touch up patched areas. If you're patching tiny nail holes, you can cover up the repairs by dabbing on touch-up paint with a soft cloth. If you're patching a large number of holes and other damage, prime the patched walls before repainting -- especially if you're choosing a semi-gloss or shinier finish.

Place the pointed nozzle of the seam adhesive under the loose edge, seam, or tear and squeeze enough adhesive to coat the torn area. Don't apply so much that it get drippy. Let the adhesive dry for 15 minutes. Some new products dry solid within a few minutes, so be sure to follow the manufacturer's directions.

Allow to dry and carefully sand flush using a sanding sponge. Seal the patched area with a little paste. Now take a piece of the left over wallpaper and lay it over the area to be repaired until the pattern matches. Mark an area on the replacement piece of wallpaper, large enough to cover the patch appx 6" sq or so and cut it out.

To repair bubbles, moisten the area with a clean, damp cloth. Using a utility knife or sharp razor blade, slit the bubble. Avoid making a straight cut—a V-shaped slit or one that follows the wallpaper's pattern will conceal the cut and make gluing easier. With a narrow putty knife, force glue through the slit.
