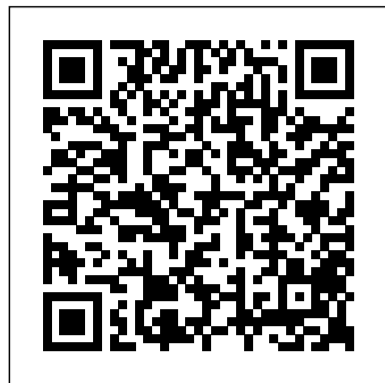


Ways To Separate A Solution

The two most common methods are distillation and evaporation, but there are other ways to separate the two compounds. Separate Salt and Water Using Distillation You can boil or evaporate the water and the salt will be left behind as a solid.

Ways To Separate A Solution

To separate salt from water with a basic evaporation experiment, start by putting a few cups of water in a pan and placing it on a hot burner. When the water heats up, add teaspoons of salt at a time, stirring them in as you go, until the salt no longer dissolves. Next, turn the burner off and allow the water to cool slightly.

There are four basic ways to separate solutions. These methods are filtering, distillation, crystallization, and chromatography. Filtering uses a type of filter to separate suspension particles. Crystallization is used in separating solutions by forming crystals and distillation is used in solutions to separate a liquid from a precipitate.

How can we Separate a Mixture of Two Solids. The solid substance which undergoes sublimation is said to ' sublime '. The process of sublimation is used to separated those substances from a mixture which sublime on heating. The solid substance obtained by cooling the vapour is known as sublimate. Ex. Ammonium chloride, Iodine, Camphor, . can be separated from a mixture by sublimation.
