Playing a critical role in both influencing climate change and mitigating its impacts, the world's diverse wetlands have become one of the world's most

threatened ecosystems as unsustainable ecology, based on results from long-term land-use practices coupled with irrational use of water have already resulted in large-scale wetlands loss and degradation. On his wedding day in 1842, Nathaniel Hawthorne escorted his new wife, Sophia, to their first home, the Old Manse in Concord, Massachusetts. He tried to take up writing one last time, but deteriorating health found him withdrawing into private life. In Hawthorne in Concord, acclaimed historian Philip McFarland paints a revealing portrait of this well-loved American author during three distinct periods of his life, spent in the bucolic village of Concord, Massachusetts. “I
