References to books should include the following: The author (s), or editor (s) - by surname and initial (s), in CAPITALS. The title (in italics or bold). The edition other than the first (if applicable). The publisher's name. Year of publication. Edited publications.

For entries in encyclopedias, dictionaries, and other reference works, cite the entry name as you would any other work in a collection but do not include the publisher information. Also, if the reference book is organized alphabetically, as most are, do not list the volume or the page number of the article or item.

Write the name of the author in parentheses, along with the year a work was published and the page number you are referencing. Place this at the end of your sentence, before the period. For example, "In the novel Being in Love, love is defined as a social impulse" (Smith, 1999, p. 17).

URL and Date Accessed For webpages you need to include the full URL of the page (http://www... etc.) and the date you last accessed the page.

Citations of books in your Reference List should begin with the last name of the book's author, then the author's initials. Next, write the year of publication within parentheses. After the year, list the title of the book in sentence case -- only capitalize the first word of the title and subtitle, if applicable, just as if you were writing a sentence.

However, a title you'd place in quotation marks within the body of the paper (such as the title of an article within a journal) will be written in normal lettering and will not be in quotation marks.

How to Cite a Book from a Database in MLA Make sure to: Provide advanced information for the book if it is available. Leave out the URL unless the source cannot be located without it. Type in the date the book was electronically published if it is available.

### When Referencing A Book In

The basic structure of a book reference should list the author's last name, first initials, publication year, book title, location, and publisher. Your reference should appear as follows: Author, I. N. (Year).

Book – APA Reference List General Tips. Capitalization: Book title and chapter title are in sentence case – Only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized. Always capitalize the first word, the first word after a colon or a dash. State/Country: Include two-letter state or province abbreviation (if U.S.A or Canada) or name of country (if not U.S.A. or Canada).
