Christians saw the Jewish faith as an aberration that had to be quashed. Jews were sometimes forced to convert or they were not allowed to practise certain professions.

List saw national unity as "primarily a process of social integration," and that, combined with the fact that many Christian Germans regarded Jews "as a possible threat" to their own social prospects, meant that the state had a duty to protect the Christian majority.42 In 1830, he remarked: "No community should be burdened with certain classes of people whose religion or general character is incompatible with upstanding society, i.e., Jews, separatists, etc."

The maverick historian G ö tz Aly, however, confidently contends that the answer is rather simple: sheer envy at rapid Jewish economic and cultural success and perceived domination (as opposed to Christian immobility) formed the basis of nineteenth- and early twentieth-century German antisemitism.
