How to Change the Screen Resolution on Windows 8. From the Metro Start screen, you need to enter into the main desktop, you can do this by pressing your

keyboard Start button or by Clicking on the Desktop title. Once you ' re on the desktop, right-click on the wallpaper and click Screen resolution. From here click Resolution and select your desired resolution.

How do I adjust the screen resolution in Windows 8?

Many applications and features have a minimum or optimal screen resolution setting to use. For example, if you choose to use the " App snapping " feature in Windows 8.1, you must have a minimum screen resolution of 1366 x 768. These numbers represent the number of pixels used to display the width and height of the onscreen display.

How to Change the Resolution in Windows 8: 15 Steps

Windows 8 has a minimum resolution of 1024x768, unless you are running it in a VM. As such it doesn't support going into 1280x720 (since 720 < 768). Windows 7 allowed this, but the modes are missing from Windows 8. My video card and monitor support 1280x720.

Changing screen resolution is important in Windows 8. Higher resolutions let you see more tiles on the Start Screen, but lower resolution will let you see text better. Connecting an external monitor or TV means you ' re going to want to tweak resolution as well as which screen has which desktop.

Windows 8 Pro boots to Low (800x600) screen resolution

To select resolution settings via the Control Panel, press Win + R and enter ' Control Panel ' in Run to open it. You can click Display > Adjust resolution to open the window below. The resolution options there are a little more limited than those on the Settings app. Select a setting from the Resolution drop-down menu and press Apply.

Windows 10 give you more options but if it isn ' t listing the optimal resolution for a connected display, or it isn ' t listing the one you want to use, here ' s how you can add it.
