Wound, Ostomy and Continence Nurse A wound ostomy-continence nurse (WOCNs) cares for patients who have active wounds or the potential to develop wounds. They also care for patients who have ostomies. Wounds may be surgical in nature or may be the result of skin breakdown, disease or injury.

Identify peristomal skin changes that would suggest evaluation by WOC nurse/NSWOC or physician; Ensure the skin barrier is sized to fit closely around stoma base; Change barrier if experiencing burning, itching, and leakage; Change pouching system at intervals that provide predictable and reliable wear time and help maintain healthy skin

In addition, care by a WOC nurse can help patients maintain the seal of a pouching system for a predictable period without leakage, thus protecting the peristomal skin.^{20,21,23} When complications develop, management by a WOC nurse is essential for the patient's recovery, which then increases the health-related quality of life.¹² Harris and Shannon²⁴ determined that WOC nurses are important leaders in patient care and reduce patients' health care costs.

Skin Care Guidelines. Cleanse the skin and protect it with one or more moisture barrier products after each incontinent episode. Apply and remove moisture barrier products (e.g. creams, ointments, pastes, liquid barrier films) per manufacturer instructions.

WOCN 2016 Guideline for Prevention and Management of ...

The skin barrier opening should be adjusted with each pouch change to be one-eighth of an inch larger than the stoma. The skin should be cleaned with water and allowed to dry. Antibacterial soaps are not recommended because they can affect the normal flora of the skin. The pouch should be placed on dry skin.
