The emphasis on organizational change in the corporate life of recent years-including job redesign, autonomous groups, high performance work systems, and the redesign of control systems-owes a great deal to the pioneering work of Chris Argyris. This book examines how individuals in organizations can become more effective, in turn making organizations more effective. It explores the conventional pyramidal structure of organizations, in which there is top-down control by managers over workers, and examines their negative consequences. These include organizational injustice and eventually irrational decision-making. Argyris also discusses the characteristic learning system of the modern organization, which he describes as "single-loop" in character. This system, he argues, is only adequate enough to permit the organization to implement existing policies. It does not permit the more difficult and comprehensive task of questioning underlying goals and assumptions, which he terms "doubt loop" learning. In this kind of learning, the organization is able to

confront the more difficult problems that affect organizations in a time of transition. In his new introduction, Argyris reviews the strengths and limitations of the argument advanced in "Integrating the Individual and the Organization." He describes why the pyramidal structure endures, and why creating a self-learning organization is an even more challenging task than he has imagined. The book will be of interest to professionals with a long-standing interest in organizational development as well as those just entering the field, managers confronting the challenge of organization change, and researchers in organizational behavior and theory.

When examining the picture, use an adequate light table or picture monitor. Do not examine x-rays, for example,

against a window. The background lighting should be dim. Always compare present abnormalities with findings in earlier x-rays if they are available. Was the abnormality present already in the earlier x-ray? Has it become larger or declined? Interpretation of the chest x-ray is not simple. Ask for interpretation by a radiologist if necessary. A chest x-ray that appears normal at first sight may hide significant pathology, e.g. behind the heart, mediastinum or diaphragm. Erroneous interpretation of an x-ray image is often associated with problems of perception. Many normal structures (e.g. cross-sections of blood vessels) and/or their superimposed projections may also cause false positive interpretations. The radiation dose from a chest x-ray is rather low (postero-anterior x-ray about 0.03 mSv, corresponding to 3 days' natural background radiation, and lateral x-ray about twice as much).

Until recently, the philosophy and history of science
 proceeded in a separate way from the philosophy and
 history of technology, and indeed with respect to both
 science and technology, philosophical and historical
 inquiries were also following their separate ways. Now we
 see in the past quarter-century how the philosophy of
 science has been profoundly influenced by historical
 studies of the sciences, and no longer concerned so single-

mindedly with the analysis of theory and explanation, with
 the relation between hypotheses and experimental
 observation. Now also we see the traditional historical
 studies of technology supplemented by philosophical
 questions, and no longer so plainly focussed upon contexts
 of application, on invention and practical engineering, and
 on the mutually stimulating relations between technology
 and society. Further, alas, the neat division of intellectual
 labor, those clearly drawn distinctions between science and
 technology, between the theoretical and the applied,
 between discovery and justification, between internalist and
 externalist approaches . . . all, all have become muddled!
 Partly, this is due to internal revolutions within the
 philosophy and history of science (the first result being
 recognition of their mutual relevance). Partly, however, this
 state of 'muddle' is due to external factors: science, at the
 least in the last half-century, has become so intimately
 connected with technology, and technological developments
 have created so many new fields of scientific (and
 philosophical) inquiry that any critical reflection on scientific
 and technological endeavors must henceforth take their
 interaction into account.
