13% of the shoreline
globally and around 5% in
Europe. Coastal lagoons
are shallow water bodies
separated from the ocean
by a barrier (e.g., narrow
spit), connected at least
intermittently to the ocean
by one or more restricted

inlets, and usually
geographically oriented
parallel to the shore-line.
Coastal lagoons are
flexible and usually able to
cope with environmental
change, yet nowadays
they are under threat. This
is partly due to climate
change impacts (for
example, sea-level rise
and hydro-meteorological
extreme events) but also
due to more direct human
activities and pressures.
The book focuses on
addressing these
challenges through

integrated management strategies seen in a land-sea and science-stakeholder-policy perspective.
