Linger in the background, like a subtle bass line,

are the quiet concerns of how we spend our time and how our priorities shift as we proceed through life. For *Piano Lessons* is really an adventure story filled with obstacles to overcome and grand leaps forward, eccentric geniuses and quiet moments of pre-dawn practice, as Noah Adams travels across country and keyboard, pursuing his dream and keeping the rhythm.
