Fourth Branch Purpose: On a day-to-day basis, the federal bureaucracy carries out much of the work of the U.S. government. Yet the bureaucracy, sometimes known as "the fourth branch," is perhaps the least known and understood part of the federal government.

The federal bureaucracy is part of the executive branch, which means that the president exercises ultimate control over it. But managing a bureaucracy this large is too difficult for one person, so there is an agency—the Executive Office of the President—that assists the

president in running the federal bureaucracy.
